Baby Bunny Season

Louisiana has both cottontail and swamp rabbits, and yes, they swim. This is birthing season for both species. Most of our calls about baby rabbits come from people who have found a nest while gardening, mowing, or starting burn piles. Consider working around the nest, as it only takes two to three weeks for the babies to leave the nest. At that point they are able to hop away from your fire or mower. If you see a baby rabbit, observe it from a distance to see if it's injured or orphaned. If you're concerned about a rabbit's well being,



reach out to us at 985 630-1009 for guidance. Rabbits are quite fragile by temperament and physiology, requiring different formulas and feeding schedules from most other mammals. Save yourself the heartache of trying unsuccessfully to raise them yourself. That's what we are here for.
